

What happens if an employee wants to pay a one off AVC into the Sky Pension Plan?

It is important for the employee to be aware of their Annual Allowance, as Sky is not liable for any additional tax an employee may have to pay as a result of going over their Annual Allowance. To make a one-off payment to into the Sky Pension Plan:

Writing a Cheque

An employee should:

- 1. Write the cheque out to "Trustees of the Sky Pension Plan"
- 2. Complete an AVC form
- 3. Send to Sky Pension Buck (Manchester), PO Box 324, Mitcheldean, GL14 9BJ

Or

Paying by Transfer

An employee should:

- 1. Make a payment to "Trustees of the Sky Pension Plan", Account Number 20558360 Sort Code 30-80-12 add name and payroll number as reference.2. Complete an AVC form
- 3. Send AVC form to Sky Pension Buck (Manchester), PO Box 324, Mitcheldean, GL14 9BJ

Reclaiming Tax

The employee will not receive any tax relief either via the payroll or from the pension provider, so will need to contact HMRC to reclaim their tax relief.
